




A pie chart showing which people in the world have no chance of learning about Jesus from someone within their own people group.





### People of the World Who Identify as Christians




About 33% of the world's population identify themselves as Christians








### The Remaining Frontier Mission Task





#### The Original Pie Chart of 1978

If you compare this picture with the Last Frontiers pie chart of 2018, you will notice that there has been significant progress in almost every geographic area, especially in China.

Today almost half of the nonbelievers are culturally-near to significant numbers of believers. The remaining missionary task of reaching the culturally-distant non-believers is much smaller.

However, the vast majority of missionaries still go to the Christian areas of the world.
